WORKSHOP ON “RISING TECHNOLOGY IN NURSING EDUCATION AND EMOTIONAL WELLBEING OF NURSES”

On 15th June 2023, students of Basic BSC Nursing 4th year organized a workshop on the topic “Rising technology in Nursing Education and Emotional well-being of Nurses”. The organizers of the Workshop were students of Basic BSC Nursing 4th year as part of the syllabus of the subject “Management of Nursing education and Services”.
